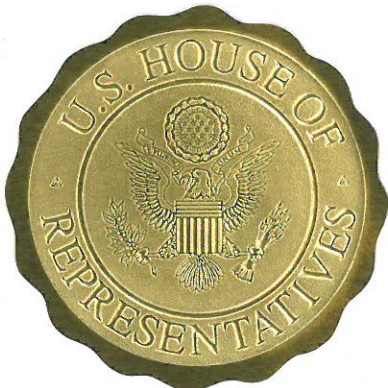

This project represents a promise for the residents of McHenry County, as it brings much-needed affordable housing options to the community.
